

NEW YORK CITY MISSION CHARTER

We pledge as a City Mission - this our commitment - to follow certain principles and pathways but only with this caveat:

Disclaimer

We do not hire or fire, We work with whoever is willing and they would be the workers through whom the job is being done. However, our guarantee about our trainers is that they will not train or teach what they do not practice and obey.

Our clients become our staff as a constant part of our process, and our pathways are designed to help us propagate our principles to people we find as they move from

person of peace =>available disciple =>spreader of the word to where it is needed

So guarantees as to outcomes are only as provided by God in His Word.

Having said that, His Word, once conveyed by someone who is filled with the Spirit, has enough power to heal, transform and form Christ in those that hear the word.

In the light of God's promises,

1. We promise to accurately convey the Word, because a message corrupted by poor education or by blindness, confusion or distraction, dilution or extension by the enemy will not produce the results that the pure word of God will produce.
 - a. **Therefore our practice will be to have clients read the word for themselves in an understandable, and universally accessible translation such as the New Living Translation or the NIV.**
2. As per the example of Jesus, we will apply a filter and will shift those who are not faithful and available and teachable onto a slower track facilitated by one of our partners
3. We will apply duckling discipleship in our accelerated discipleship track
4. We will search for persons of peace
5. We consider that the multiplication discipleship system is a complete and authoritative representation of church, provided that it follows the principle of every person being a member of 2 groups, and we hold that this system of church is able to sustain the required rate of development of disciples into the character of Christ. It is, in its own right, a part of the body of Christ, without needing to be a subsystem within a parent congregational church.

- a. Its leaders should be recognized as leaders within the church in the city, because of their fidelity to the Scriptures, to the Lord Jesus and their love and honour for the body of Christ. This is wholly consistent with the picture presented in Acts of a united church in three expressions: house, congregation and city.
6. We hold that any microchurch system that appears to hate the body of Christ and is fixated on destroying its reputation is actually a work of the flesh, cleverly manipulated by Satan to work against the Kingdom of God, and should be lovingly rebuked and brought into good order.
7. The multiplication discipleship mission pilot is a pilot of a multi-level multiplication discipleship system that loves, promotes and partners with the existing church. We believe in church reformation, and seek to draw the congregational church into reformation by loving and blessing it.
8. We also believe in forgiveness, grace and generosity and we offer to ministries that have acknowledged and repented of sin, the same grace that we ourselves have received.
9. We will preach and expect individual repentance and receive individual members who might be members of errant churches on an individual basis, not on the basis of either the errant or the repentant reputation of their congregation.
10. We will track our process and are able to give an assessment of every individual in terms of faithfulness, teachability and availability and also their status devoid of its terms of baptism, deliverance, Holy Spirit infilling, training and competence, seed sowing, faith, consecration, prayer, worship and abiding in Christ.
11. We will maintain a link between missionaries and intercessors that is secure, devoid of pictures, name and location details, and welcoming of prophetic insights while committed to testing every prophetic word - irrespective of how reputable the source is.
12. We commit to obey the laws of the land unless those laws directly contradict the clear teaching of Scripture. We are committed to respect, honour and obey Christian leadership in the city, unless those leaders are directly contradicting and rebelling against the leadership and instructions of Jesus our Lord as communicated in Scripture.
13. We are not a training institution. Our job is not to train the church - rather we are a discipleship mission that spreads the Gospel by means of training.
 - a. Our objective at this point is not to train the church, but to demonstrate multiplication discipleship to the congregational church by implementing multiplication discipleship as a fellowship of microchurches.
 - b. During this pilot period, the City Mission will take care of the entire discipleship process in a 100% transparent way and we desire to partner with congregational churches in prayer and resources in order to see this happen.

14. When we transition to the training phase of the mission, in which the objectives of the the mission will be gradually handed over to a fellowship of congregational churches and mission organizations, we will then seek to find the best ways of delivering the required training for churches with the help of our partners.
