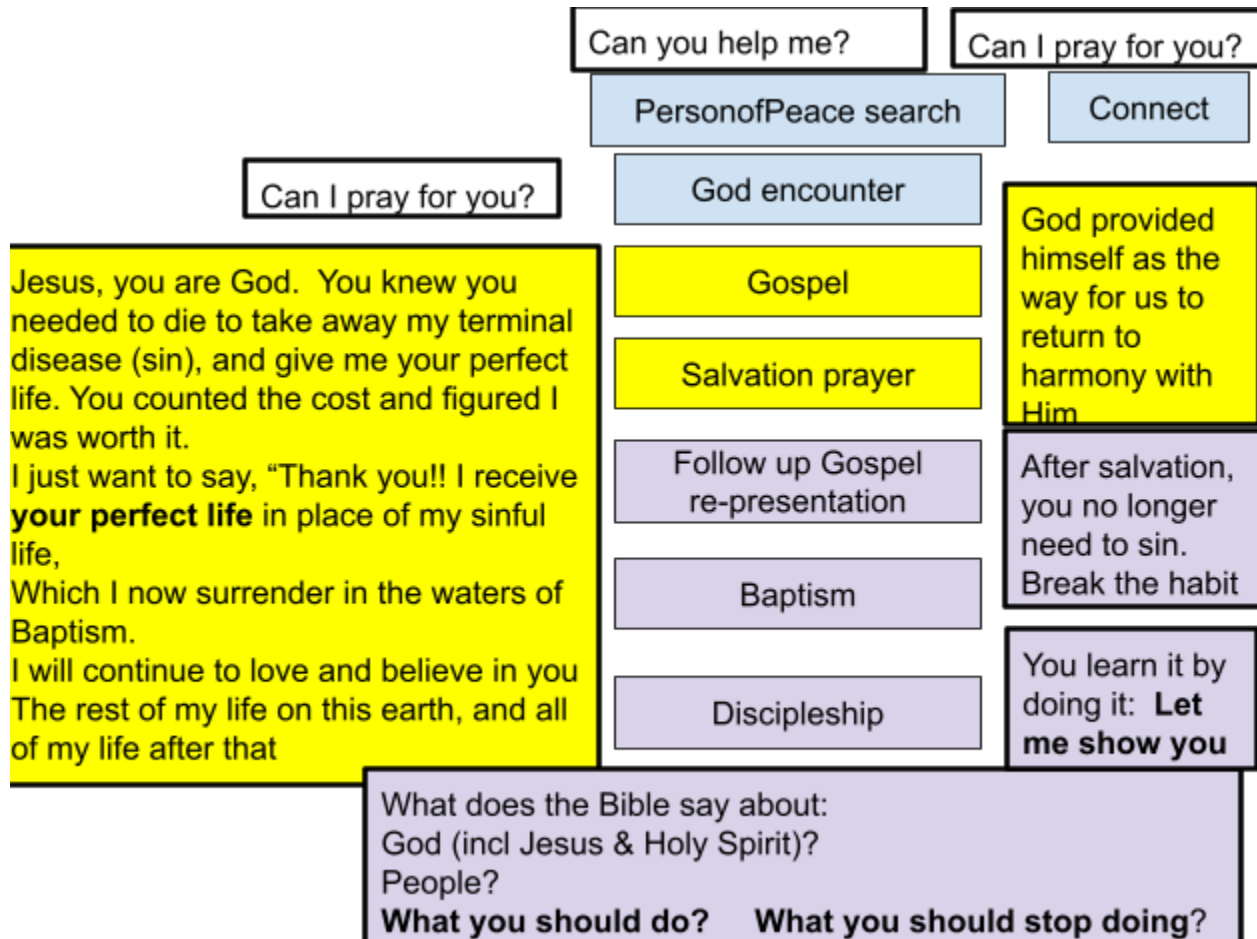


Gospel conversations:

These are faith filled conversations that transform cities

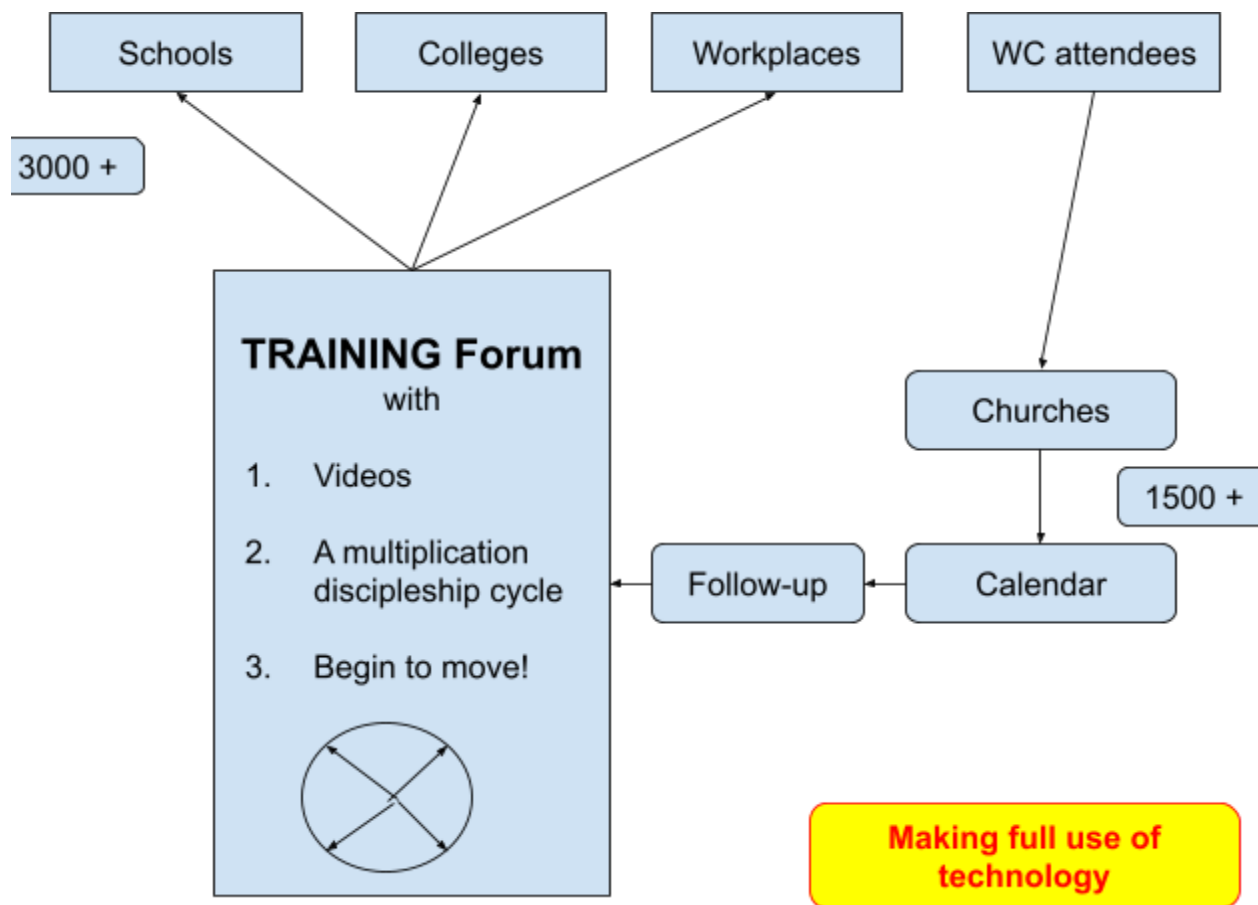
1. Can **we** do your follow-up?

The technology referred to here is a simple automated walkthrough that steps you through the list of videos and integrates training with practice as indicated in the following page. Essentially it steps you through a weekly rhythm of activities and points to the relevant videos that train for each activity. **The next page** sets out the way the videos should be used to make the activities effective. Note the order. The activities must happen anyway - the training simply makes the activities efficient and effective. We are definitely on the lookout for the opposite mindset - a training first mindset which allows for activities not actually happening, so long as training occurs...

STEP 1: Watch the video

The beginning of the video would contain a prayer which would be silently offered for help in conducting the interaction in faith and in the power of the Holy Spirit

STEP 2: Follow the steps in the video and do as instructed, noting the Scriptures that provide the instructions we are following. On the basis of faith in the Word of God, expect what is promised in the Scriptures.

STEP 3. Apply the principle of importunity which is an expression of faith in the character of the One who made the promise

STEP 4: Maintain time control as strictly as you can. Search for every opportunity to either terminate the interaction politely or make definite arrangements for the interaction to be continued at a later (agreed) time, so that the interaction time does not exceed what is recommended for your context.

STEP 5. Move onto the next person or the next interaction (trained by a different video) **with the same person.** Praise God for the boldness he gave you in the previous interaction and express your confidence that He will supply the same boldness for this new interaction.

NOTES:

- a. Try to follow the steps in the video exactly when you are in the field, even taking some time to rewatch an interaction you are less confident about before interacting with a new person. If a stranger asks you what you are watching, show them and walk through the video with them. This will help you to learn the video, and also to indicate to persons you meet that after they have come to faith, they can do what you are doing.
- b. Once the presentation has been learned after a few reps in the field, you will find that it can be varied as led by the Spirit, maybe extending or elaborating on certain elements as you are led.
- c. Use WhatsApp to debrief and fellowship about what the Lord has done, scheduling impromptu calls if necessary.
- d. Keep your group small!!! by starting new groups and by each person remaining a member of two groups (hence the time restrictions above).

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
